<b>Highlights:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Need of financial and operational solution to ensure appropriate human and material resources to be invested in cooperation activities;</li><li>- High importance of planning key players' fruitful engagement for implementing a Knowledge Triangle;</li><li>- Student-centered learning focus on skills and competence essential for Logistics;</li><li>- Quality Assurance more important for HEIs, in accordance with their usual compliance requirement, less for Business;</li><li>- Strategic long-term cooperation considered important to ensure a continuum in the collaboration planning</li></ul>
